ORDER NO. R5-

**RESCINDING CEASE AND DESIST ORDERS**

- a. **Nancy C. Cleavinger, Nancy C. Cleavinger Revocable Trust et. al., Jackson Road Landfill, Sacramento.** On 10 December 2010, the Central Valley Water Board adopted Cease and Desist Order (CDO) R5-2010-0119 for the Jackson Road Landfill to provide a timeline to close the landfill as required by WDRs Oder R5-2003-0075.

The Discharger constructed a soil cover with a one percent or greater slope, perimeter drainage ditches, and a detention basin. The CDO required the submittal of multiple reports during the phased closure. The Discharger has successfully met those requirements. A final Construction Quality Certification Report was submitted in accordance with the CDO indicating the final soil cover was constructed to design specifications approved in the Final Closure Post Closure Maintenance Plan. Staff issued a letter dated 12 November 2014 approving the final Construction Quality Assurance Report certifying the landfill as closed. This letter also certified that the Discharger has complied with all conditions of the CDO.

- b. **City of Winters Wastewater Treatment Plant**

On 25 January 2007, the Central Valley Water Board adopted Cease and Desist Order (CDO) R5-2007-0002 for the City of Winters to address ongoing violations of the Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs). The CDO required the Discharger to address sanitary sewer overflows from the wastewater collection system and submit a background groundwater quality study. The City has completed all the required tasks in Order R5-2007-0002 and addressed the sanitary sewer overflows by investigating, repairing and retrofitting the wastewater collection system lift stations. Additionally, the City has implemented a sanitary sewer operation, maintenance, and overflow prevention plan.

The City of Winters has complied with the CDO and has returned to compliance with the WDRs.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Cease and Desist and Time Schedule Orders are rescinded.
