1. Limitations and Discharge Requirements – Best Management Practices and Pollution Prevention. Section VI.C.3.a

Modify the requirement for the Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan as shown in underline/strikeout format below:

- a. **Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan.** The Discharger shall ~~update and~~ continue to implement a salinity evaluation and minimization plan to identify and address sources of salinity discharged from the Facility to both groundwater and surface water. ~~The updated plan shall be completed and submitted to the Central Valley Water Board within 9 months of the effective date of this Order.~~ The Discharger shall evaluate the effectiveness of the salinity evaluation and minimization plan and provide a summary with the Report of Waste Discharge, due 180 days prior to the permit expiration date. ~~annual reports demonstrating reasonable progress in the reduction of salinity in its discharge to Mill Creek. The annual reports shall be submitted in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program (Attachment E, section X.D.1).~~

2. Attachment E, Monitoring and Reporting Program – Table E-12. Reporting Requirements for Special Provisions Reports

Remove the rows regarding the Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan, as shown in strikeout format below:

3. Attachment F, Fact Sheet – Best Management Practices and Pollution Prevention. Section VI.B.3.a

Modify the rationale for the Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan requirement as shown in underline/strikeout format below:

- a. **Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan.** An Salinity Evaluation and Minimization Plan for salinity is required to continue to be implemented ~~updated and submitted to the Central Valley Water Board~~ to ensure adequate measures are developed and implemented by the Discharger to reduce the discharge of salinity to both groundwater and surface water ~~Mill Creek.~~ The Discharger is required to evaluate the effectiveness of its salinity evaluation and minimization plan during the permit term and provide a summary with the Report of Waste Discharge, due 180 days prior to permit expiration.

4. **Limitations and Discharge Requirements – Compliance Determination. Section VII**

Add new compliance determination language regarding the Industrial Storm Water Action Levels, as shown below:

- C. Industrial Storm Water Action Levels (Section VI.C.2.c, Table 6).** The industrial storm water action levels in Table 6 are not effluent limitations on the industrial storm water discharge. An exceedance of an action level does not constitute a violation of this Order. The action levels are the pollutant concentrations above which the Central Valley Water Board has determined represent a level of concern and require further evaluation of the Discharger's SWPPP as it relates to controlling the discharge of the subject pollutant from the Facility. Exceedance of an action level requires the Discharger to conduct a BMP Improvement Plan in accordance with Section VI.C.2.c.
