TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Ardagh Glass Inc. and Air Liquide Industrial U.S. Limited Partnership (glass manufacturing facility) at 24441 Avenue 12 in Madera. The facility manufactures glass and proposes to continue discharging domestic wastewater to on-site evaporation/percolation ponds and cooling tower blowdown to an on-site fire water pond and land application area. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 21/22 April 2016 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 4 March 2016**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative WDRs have been sent only to the Dischargers. Others are advised that the tentative WDRs are available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at:
