Hearing: April 21/22, 2016

The Prosecution Team for the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region ("Central Valley Water Board") ("Prosecution Team") hereby submits an objection to the 11 March 2016 *Evidence and Witness List* submitted by Mr. Neal E. Costanzo on behalf of the Malaga County Water District ("Discharger"). The Discharger's *Evidence and Witness List* violates the Hearing Procedures for this matter and would result in a waste of resources.


This objection is aimed only at the time limits listed in the Discharger's submittal, not to the particular evidentiary documents or witnesses identified. The Discharger was provided an opportunity to object to the Hearing Procedures and failed to raise a timely objection. While the Prosecution Team may have supported a reasonable and justifiable request for additional time at hearing, 50 hours would amount to a waste of the Central Valley Water Board's and staff's time and resources. The Prosecution Team respectfully requests that the time limits established in the Hearing Procedures be upheld.
