### NOTICE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SIERRA PACIFIC INDUSTRIES CHINESE CAMP MILL TUOLUMNE COUNTY

#### TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Sierra Pacific Industries, Chinese Camp Mill at 14333 Perricone Road in Tuolumne County. The tentative WDRs will regulate the discharge of wastewater and industrial storm water runoff from the log deck and sawmill operations to land. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 21/22 April 2016 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 29 February 2016**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
