TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order and the tentative Time Schedule Order for the City of Live Oak (Discharger), Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility). Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Orders should be submitted to this office via email to **RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov**, no later than 5:00 p.m. on **2 June 2016** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board). Written material submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **2 June 2016** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Board Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Orders at its **23/24 June 2016** Board Meeting. A Notice of Public Hearing (Notice) concerning the tentative Orders is also enclosed. Regulations require that the Discharger publish the Notice in a local newspaper for one (1) day. The expense of publication is to be paid by the Discharger. Additionally, regulations require that the Discharger post one (1) copy of the Notice at the nearest city hall or county courthouse, one (1) copy at the post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and one (1) copy at the public entrance to the Facility. Please publish and post the Notice as soon as possible and submit to this office proof of posting, using the enclosed form, and proof of publication by **17 May 2016**. Proof of publication

shall consist of an affidavit from the newspaper along with a copy of the published notice. In addition, if possible, please post the Notice on the Discharger's website.
