



Relationship Between the Municipal Stormwater General Order, the Stormwater Management Plan, the Annual Report, and the Annual Workplan

General Order




- Issued by the Central Valley Regional Board
- Order is for Phase I and Phase II MS4s in Region 5
- Phase II MS4s may enroll under this Order or continue to be regulated under the Statewide Phase II Small MS4 Permit
- Permittees submit Notice Of Intent (NOI) to enroll under Order
- Order includes provisions for the prioritization and development of the Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP)
- The monitoring, assessment, and reporting program (MARP) includes the provisions for the development of the monitoring program (included in the SWMP)
- SWMP is enforceable component of the Order

Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP)



- Pursuant to the General Order, MS4 develops the SWMP
- SWMP is the local strategic plan for complying with the Order
- The SWMP identifies the general approach that will be implemented by the MS4, however the specificity is provided in the Annual Workplan
- SWMP identifies the local priorities, programs, and activities that may be implemented as needed over the permit term
- SWMP is submitted to Regional Board for approval

Annual Report & Annual Workplan



- Pursuant to the General Order, MS4 develops Annual Workplans
- Workplans provide mechanism for adaptive management of the stormwater program
- Annual Report evaluates program effectiveness and identifies program modifications
- Workplan implements modifications identified in the Annual Report
- Workplan identifies specific actions to be implemented in the upcoming year(s) [submitted with Annual Report]
- Workplan is approved by the EO
