




The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB) conducted an initial screening study in the San Joaquin River Watershed to evaluate logistical needs for a region-wide Recreation Beneficial Use study, using *E. coli* as an indicator, with a guideline 235 MPN/100mL. 
**E. coli Levels
Labor Day Recreation Study (2007)**




**Specific Conductivity Levels
