RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

**FOR
MEADOWBROOK DAIRY**

San Bernardino County_____

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Water Board) finds:

1. Board Order No. R6V-2002-0024 was adopted on April 10, 2002, establishing requirements for the discharge of animal waste from Meadowbrook Dairy operations. Waste Discharge Requirements are no longer necessary for the reasons described below and should be rescinded.
2. The dairy is comprised of three parcels located in the El Mirage hydrologic area of the Mojave Hydrologic Unit. The dairy generated manure, milk parlor wash water, and corral area stormwater runoff that was disposed onto adjacent agricultural fields. Meadowbrook Dairy sent a letter, dated January 21, 2013, stating that the dairy site was sold to the Phelan-Pinon Hills Community Services District and the dairy ceased operations on November 14, 2012. Water Board staff inspected the dairy on February 6, 2013, and verified that all feed, chemicals, wash water and manure have been removed and properly disposed. Therefore, Board Order No. R6V-2002-0024 should be rescinded because there is no ongoing discharge and the dairy site is cleaned up.
3. This action is being taken by this regulatory agency to rescind Board Order No. R6V-2002-0024. Orders issued pursuant to the California Water Code and as such is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.), in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15321(a)(2).
4. The Water Board has notified the Discharger and interested persons and agencies of its intent to rescind the above Waste Discharge Requirements.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Board Order No., R6V-2002-0024 be rescinded.
