**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

In the matter of Rescission of Cease and Desist Order No. 6-91-857 for Gregory A. Babb.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that**, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Regional Board), will hold a public hearing during the Regional Board's regular meeting beginning at 7 p.m. November 17, 2004, at the Town of Truckee Council Chambers, 10183 Truckee Airport Road, Truckee, California, to consider rescission of Cease and Desist Order No. 6-91-857 for Gregory A. Babb. Mr. Babb is no longer discharging wastes to a septic system within the Stones-Bengard subdivision at Eagle Lake, Lassen County.

This public hearing is intended to provide Mr. Babb, his representatives, and the public with an opportunity to address this matter. The Regional Board will then have the opportunity to affirm or reject the Rescission.

The Regional Board hereby gives notice that it will accept written and oral testimony in this matter. Written testimony must be submitted to the Regional Board by November 7, 2004.

Interested persons are invited to attend and testify on this issue. Persons making presentations should confine statements to the issues pertinent to this hearing only. Oral testimony should be brief and may be limited by the Regional Board Chairman to allow all interested persons time to be heard.

The proposed Rescission Order, and related documents pertaining to this issue may be inspected and copied at the Regional Board's South Lake Tahoe office between 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon and 1:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. at the above-referenced address.
