RESOLUTION NO. 76-21

REVISION OF WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN
FOR
EAST COLORADO RIVER BASIN, 7B

- WHEREAS, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, in Resolution No. 75-22, dated April 10, 1975, adopted the Water Quality Control Plan for the East Colorado River Basin (7B); and
- WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted its Resolution No. 75-28, thereby approving said Plan, in accordance with Section 13245 of the California Water Code; and
- WHEREAS, in adopting said Resolution No. 75-28, the State Water Resources Control Board expressed concerns about certain features of the Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency, in a letter to the Governor, approved Chapters 2 and 4 of the Plan, in accordance with Federal Regulation 40 CFR 131.202; and
- WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency's approval of the Plan was conditional; and
- WHEREAS, the Water Quality Control Plan is a part of the State's continuing planning process; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed revisions presented in Attachment 1 satisfy concerns of the State Water Resources Control Board, fulfill the conditions of approval of the Plan stipulated by the Environmental Protection Agency, and in addition update the Plan to reflect existing conditions; and
- WHEREAS, the Regional Board is concerned whether there is and/or will be standards enforcement on the Nevada and Arizona sides of the Colorado River equivalent to that which is undertaken on the California side of the River; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED,

1. That the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region hereby adopts the revisions to the Water Quality Control Plan for the East Colorado River Basin (7B) as stated in attachment; and
2. In adopting this resolution, it is the intent of the Regional Board that the enforcement of these amendments will be in coordination with equivalent enforcement on the Nevada and Arizona sides of the Colorado River; and
3. That the Water Quality Control Plan amendments shall become effective upon approval by the State Water Resources Control Board.
