CANCELLATION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 71-2
AND ADDENDUMS THERETO AGAINST MECCA SANITARY DISTRICT


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The water quality control problems which necessitated the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2, and Addendums No. 1 and No. 2 to Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2, have been resolved to the satisfaction of the Board.
2. Enforcement actions, as specified in Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2 and Addendums, are no longer required.
3. It is desirable to cancel Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2 and the Addendums thereto.
4. The Board forwarded timely notice by mail to persons responsible for the Mecca Sanitary District facilities, and to all other affected persons, explaining its intent to cancel same.
5. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2 and the Addendums thereto.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2, and Addendums No. 1 and No. 2 to Cease and Desist Order No. 71-2, are hereby cancelled.
