ORDER NO. 79-19

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders containing waste discharge requirements apply to waste discharges which have ceased or have decreased below 1500 gallons-per-day.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders who submitted the original reports of waste discharge, who are also indicated to be the persons in present interest, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescinding of the below-listed Orders.
