
RESOLUTION NO. 80-20

ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL AGRICULTURAL WATER QUALITY
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, the jurisdictional boundary of this Regional Board encompasses vast agricultural areas; and
- WHEREAS, under Federal and State laws and regulations increasing emphasis is being placed upon water quality characteristics associated with agricultural discharge; and
- WHEREAS, under the provisions of Division 7 of the California Water Code, the State Water Resources Control Board and each Regional Water Quality Control Board are the principal state agencies with primary responsibility for the coordination and control of water quality; and
- WHEREAS, it would be highly beneficial to the work of this Regional Board, in its water quality activities, to have a means of obtaining coordinated assistance and advice from persons engaged in the scientific and operational phases of agricultural activities; and
- WHEREAS, on January 29, 1976, this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 76-16, establishing its Regional Agricultural Water Quality Advisory Committee as a means of obtaining coordinated assistance and advice on water quality matters associated with agriculture; and
- WHEREAS, on November 28, 1979, the Chairman of this Regional Board established a Task Force to review the role and membership of the Regional Board's water quality advisory committees; and
- WHEREAS, on the recommendation of said Task Force, the Regional Board desires to revise certain portions of Resolution No. 76-16; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, 1. That this Regional Board hereby re-establishes its Regional Agricultural Water Quality Advisory Committee to assist and advise this Regional Board and its Executive Officer on water quality matters pertaining to agriculture; and

2. That the membership on this Board's Regional Agricultural Water Quality Advisory Committee shall be established for each calendar year, by motion, at the Board's first regular meeting of each year, and the committee members of the previous year are requested to continue until the new committee membership is established; and
3. That meetings of the committee shall be called by the Chairperson of the Regional Board, or by its Executive Officer upon the concurrence of the Board Chairperson; and
4. That the Chairperson of the Regional Board shall appoint a member of the Board residing in that area of the Region in which a particular meeting of the Committee will be held to serve as Meeting Coordinator.
5. That this Resolution No. 8-20 rescinds this Board's Resolution No. 76-16.
