RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Resolution and Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that are discharging less than 15,000 gallons-per-day, or are no longer in use.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Resolution and Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Resolution and Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Resolution or Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescinding of the below-listed Resolution and Orders.
