ORDER NO. 91-041

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that are no longer in use or have been closed with closure approved by Regional Board staff.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
