Project Description:

Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) plans to remove a bridge and install three culverts near the town of Wister in Imperial County, California. The replacement culverts have been sized to meet or exceed the current structure's capacity, based on a review of the 50-year and 100-year flood events, and will accommodate the existing mainline track and a future second track.

UPRR will remove the existing timber pile trestle bridge and install three culverts at the channel at MP 658.40. The replacement culverts will be 72 inches in diameter to accommodate future storm events and uphold the existing mainline and future second mainline tracks. The culverts will be made up of smooth steel pipe (SSP). The culverts will be jack and bored under the existing track embankment and the channel will be slightly re-aligned to allow flow through the culverts. Riprap will be placed at the culvert inlets and outlets.
