**Applicant:** California Department of Transportation (Caltrans)

**Project Name:** Willow Wash Bridge Scour Retrofit

**Receiving Water:** Willow Wash, a tributary to the Whitewater River

**Location:** 33° 52' 30" N. Latitude, 116° 27' 30" W. Longitude

**Project Description:** The proposed project would retrofit the upstream (north side) bridge piers of the Willow Wash Bridge (Bridge No. 56-0303) to correct scouring problems occurring at the bridge footings. The work will consist of retrofitting the footings of bents 2 and 3 by driving piles and constructing two concrete check dams. A temporary access ramp will be constructed off of Interstate-10, 100 feet west of the bridge, to allow the contractor's equipment to go down the stream bank and get in and out of the wash.
