ORDER NO. R8-2002-0043

Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements and Enforcement Orders
for
Specific Facilities

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (hereinafter Board), finds that:

1. The Orders listed in Attachment "A" were issued by the Board at various times for the facilities described therein. Attachment "A" is hereby made a part of this Order.
2. Waste discharge requirements or enforcement orders for the facilities listed in Attachment "A" are no longer necessary because the facilities are covered under other waste discharge requirements or because the facilities are connected to the sewer and are thus in compliance with enforcement orders.
3. This action is based on the cessation of discharges of waste, which poses no significant adverse impact on the environment, or on the finding that specific discharges have no significant environmental impacts. As such, this action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15061 (b) (3), Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
4. The Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind the Orders for the facilities listed in Attachment "A", and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments and recommendations.
5. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of waste discharge requirements.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the orders listed in Attachment "A" be rescinded.
