On the basis of lawful standards and regulations, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region proposes to renew waste discharge requirements for discharges of storm water runoff from the municipal separate storm sewer systems owned and/or operated by the municipalities indicated above.

The Board is seeking comments concerning this proposed action and the potential effects of the discharges on the water quality and beneficial uses of the affected receiving waters within the Santa Ana Region.
