TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2006-0049, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR PAUMA VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, PAUMA VALLEY TREATMENT PLANT, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0049, including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet which Regional Board staff intends to present to the Regional Board for adoption at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 14, 2006.

If adopted, tentative Order No. R9-2006-0049, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of treated wastewater effluent from the Pauma Valley Community Services District District's treatment plant on-site percolation ponds. If adopted, Order No. R9-2006-0049 would supercede Order No. R9-1993-0046, except for enforcement purposes. Tentative Order No. R9-2006-0049 contains updated and new standard language, as well as a new format.


