SUBJECT: REVIEW OF MONITORING REPORT FOR BAILY VINEYARD & WINERY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the January-June 2010 monitoring report which were submitted in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 2001-159.

The San Diego Water Board identified the following violation in the submitted report:

1. The Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 2001-159 Percolation Ponds C.2 requires a grab sample from the percolation ponds to be analyzed for total dissolved solids, chloride, percent sodium, sulfate, nitrate, potassium, boron, and pH. The sample was not taken.

Please be aware this violation subjects you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;¹ referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring reports required to be submitted are the July-December 2010 semiannual and January-December monitoring reports, which are due by January 30, 2011.
