**SUBJECT: REVIEW OF MONITORING REPORTS FOR CARLSBAD WATER  
RECYCLED FACILITY**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the February 2010 through July 2010 monthly, January-March 2010 and April-June 2010 quarterly monitoring reports submitted by the Encina Wastewater Authority in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. 2001-0145.

The following violations of the Order No. 2001-0145 were identified in the submitted monitoring reports:

1. The 12-month average effluent limitation for manganese of Discharge Specification B.5, established at 0.05 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded during February and March 2010 with reported values of 0.06 and 0.06 mg/L, respectively. We acknowledge that the facility is taking actions to correct the problem.
2. The daily maximum effluent limitation for manganese of Discharge Specification B.5, established at 0.06 mg/L, was exceeded on June 17, June 23, June 28, June 29, and June 30, 2010 with reported values of 0.08, 0.07, 0.07, 0.07 and 0.07 mg/L, respectively.
3. Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 2001-352 Section B.2 requires the total coliform to be monitored daily. However, the sample was not collected on April 11, 2010 and June 12, 2010.

Please be aware these violations subject you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;<sup>1</sup> and referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief.

The next monitoring report to be submitted is the August 2010 monthly monitoring report due by October 1, 2010.
