**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**CONSIDERATION OF ORDER  
REISSUING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (NPDES NO. CA0109169) and  
TIME SCHEDULE ORDER  
FOR THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY,  
NAVAL BASE SAN DIEGO COMPLEX  
SAN DIEGO COUNTY**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is proposing to reissue National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0109169 (Tentative Order No. R9-2013-0064), *Waste Discharge Requirements for the United States Department of the Navy, Naval Base San Diego Complex, San Diego County*, with Tentative Time Schedule Order No. R9-2013-0095 to ensure that the Naval Base San Diego discharges comply with the requirements in Tentative Order No. R9-2013-0064. Discharges covered by Tentative Order No. R9-2013-0064 include industrial storm water; steam condensate; pier boom, fender, and mooring cleaning; utility vault and manhole dewatering; miscellaneous discharges associated with facility maintenance; graving dock de-flooding water; caisson gate ballast water; seawater cooling overboard discharges; and saltwater supply system water.

A public hearing on these Tentative Orders will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting scheduled for **August 14, 2013** in the **Board Room, San Diego Water Board, 9174 Sky Park Court, Suite 100, San Diego, California**. The items will be heard during a meeting that starts at 9:00 A.M. The meeting agenda, which will indicate any changes in the meeting location and may provide other specific information concerning this hearing, will be posted at least two weeks prior to the meeting date at [http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/board\\_info/agendas/](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/board_info/agendas/).

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- United States Department of the Navy

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the San Diego Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on June 21, 2013**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in

particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge or how that person's interest will not be represented adequately by other designated parties.

The Tentative Order and Tentative Time Schedule Order were issued on June 7, 2013. Persons wishing to comment on these noticed hearing items shall submit testimony, if any, evidence, if any, and/or comments, in writing to the San Diego Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on July 8, 2013**. Written evidence, testimony or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on July 8, 2013**, will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the San Diego Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written comments. **No new issues not raised in timely submitted written testimony, evidence or comments will be permitted.** Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
