a. Discussion of Copermittee Priorities:

1. Support for regional Permit concept

Preliminary Tasks for Copermittee Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD)

- Comparison of three Region IX permits (San Diego, South Orange, Riverside)
- Review of existing "regional" permits (Bay Area, South Orange, Portland)

2. Continued dialogue (ongoing meetings with RWQCB staff throughout re-issuance process, development and coordination of Copermittee input)

3. Results of recently completed Copermittee visioning process:

- Simplified reporting
- Streamlined / more meaningful assessment
- Better coordinated water quality monitoring
- Enhanced TMDL focus
- Increased emphasis on strategic planning

b. Questions for of RWQCB Staff Consideration:

1. Vision: What is staff's vision for a regional Permit? Other than administrative streamlining, what does staff hope to accomplish through regionalization?

2. Schedule: What is staff's anticipated re-issuance schedule for releasing a draft Permit? What are the major milestones in that process?

3. Administrative / logistical considerations:

- How will the Permit be administered amongst the three regions?
- How will outstanding and future unfunded mandates decisions be addressed?
- How will existing differences between the three Permits be reconciled?
- Will some future requirements be different between the regions?
- How will anti-backsliding provisions apply?

4. Changes to Permit Requirements:

- What specific changes to Permit requirements are being contemplated?
- Will everything in the Orange and Riverside Permits be included in San Diego?
- What additional requirements are being considered?
