Eric and Laurie -- Thank you again for sitting down with the Copermittees to discuss potential changes to the administrative draft permit workshop process. For your consideration, the attached file contains a proposed timeline and workshop content that we believe accords with the San Diego Copermittees' priorities for discussion. As we discussed at the meeting, we believe that at least 2-3 weeks are needed between the workshops to allow the Copermittees to develop and coordinate content.

This is a County proposal, but we've incorporated input received from the cities of San Diego and Carlsbad.

Also note that we do not represent either of the other two counties. As you know, they have additional concerns that may not be addressed by our proposed changes. We would also support additional modifications as necessary to address these concerns.
