

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD SAN DIEGO REGION

Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 27, Section 21730, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) hereby notifies the public of its intent to consider adoption of tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. 2000-54 for the Las Pulgas Landfill at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton in San Diego County. If adopted, the tentative Addendum would re-establish the landfill composite liner requirements to those prescriptive standards included in State Water Resources Control Board Resolution No. 93-62, California Code of Regulations, Title 27, and the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, Part 258.

The Regional Board wishes to obtain information to assist it in determining the proper requirements for the proposed action. A public meeting will be held by the Regional Board to consider the proposed action. The public meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday May 9, 2007 at the following location: California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Regional Board Meeting Room, 9174 Sky Park Court, Suite 100, San Diego, CA 92123. Interested persons are invited to attend to express their views on the above-mentioned item. Written comments should be received by the Regional Board office as soon as possible, and no later than April 27, 2007.
