MINUTES OF MEETING FEBRUARY 14, 2007

At 9:00 a.m. Vice Chairwoman Kraus called to order the meeting of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region at the Regional Water Quality Control Board, 9174 Sky Park Court, San Diego, California.

Steve Grassilli, Ramona resident, expressed concern about runoff of sediments going in to a stream on his property from a neighbor that graded his property. Vice Chairwoman Kraus asked staff to discuss the situation with Mr. Grassilli.

<u>Item 3</u> – Minutes of Board Meeting of January 24, 2007

Ms. Ritschel moved approval of the January 24, 2007 minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Anderson and approved with abstention by Mr. Johnson.

<u>Item 4</u> – Chairman's, Board Members', State Board liaison's and Executive Officer's Reports: These items are for Board discussion only. No public testimony will be allowed, and the Board will take no formal action.

Board Member Johnson reported that he attended a National Brownfield Association meeting on January 25 in San Diego. Staff member John Anderson also attended.

Vice Chairwoman Kraus presented staff member Jeremy Haas with a Certificate of Recognition for his ongoing commitment to customer service awarded by CalEPA.

Mr. Robertus briefly spoke about a few items in his report which included the Leaking UST Case: Rancho Car Wash, Leaking UST Case: Aztec Gas Station (Part B), and the Fostering Sustainable Behavior Workshop (Part A).

Vice Chairwoman Kraus asked questions about the Sanitary Sewer Overflows item. Mr. Robertus responded.

Board Member Ritschel requested that staff participate in informal coordination meetings with the MS4 copermittees on storm water issues. Mr. Robertus responded.

Vice Chairwoman Kraus announced that Item 5 was removed from the Consent Calendar at the request of Board Member Johnson.

<u>Item 6</u> – Amendment of Waste Discharge Requirements: General Waste Discharge Requirements for Post-Closure Maintenance of Inactive Hazardous and Nonhazardous Landfills within the San Diego Region (tentative Addendum No. 5 to Order No. 97-11) (*Amy Grove*)

<u>Item 7</u> – Authorization for Executive Officer to sign a No Further Action (NFA) letter for the 41 Area Waste Stabilization Pond - Site 9, Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton (MCBCP) (Beatrice Griffey)

Mr. Johnson made a motion to approve Consent Items 6 and 7. The motion was seconded by Ms. Ritschel and approved by unanimous vote.

<u>Item 5</u> – New NPDES Permit: San Diego State University, Research Foundation Coastal Waters Laboratory, Discharge to San Diego Bay (tentative Order No. R9-2007-0006, NPDES No. CA0109231) (*Victor Vasquez*)

Mr. Johnson asked questions of staff member Victor Vasquez and Eric Elson, San Diego State University Research Foundation.

Ms. Johnson made a motion to approve Consent Item 5. The motion was seconded by Mr. Anderson and approved by unanimous vote.

<u>Item 11</u> – Status Report: Regulation of discharges from graywater systems. The Regional Board will hear a report from staff on the current regulation of discharges from graywater treatment systems and pending changes to that regulatory scheme. (Art Coe)

Mr. Robertus introduced the item and Assistant Executive Officer Coe gave the presentation.

Mr. Wyels said the new Chair has the authority to accept the responsibilities that were accepted by the previous Chair, or to delegate them.
