

**MWD Lake Skinner Filtration Plant, 33740 Borel Road, Winchester, CA**

The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) from a gas station in Winchester, CA. This public notice fulfills the Regional Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728. The current site conditions do not pose a threat to human health or the environment, and the unauthorized release case can be closed. The case files are available for public review by submitting a file review request to the San Diego Water Board office, or on-line from the Geotracker database.
