

See attached map. Project is located south of SR76 approximately 3.5 miles east of I-15. Approximate Latitude 33° 20' 45" and Longitude 117° 6' 55".

17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE
Take SR76 east from the intersection with I-15 for approximately 3.5 miles (past and east of Couser Canyon Rd. and Wild Rd). Project site is located on the south side of the road, at the San Luis Rey River.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

Construct a bridge crossing of the San Luis Rey River to handle ingress to and egress from the Gregory Canyon Landfill. See attached reports and engineering drawings. This bridge crossing will replace an existing low-flow crossing that is located downstream, but which would not be able to support the required equipment. The existing crossing will be abandoned.

19. Project Purpose (Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions)

To allow County-approved access from SR76 across the San Luis Rey River to the Gregory Canyon Landfill for vehicles and equipment associated with construction and operation of the Landfill.

20. Reason(s) for Discharge

Structural discharges and temporary construction access.

21. Type(s) of Material Being Discharged and the Amount of Each Type in Cubic Yards

Approximately 18 cubic yards of concrete and related construction material within tightly sealed forms for three bridge supports within waters of the U.S. An unknown volume of additional base material may be temporarily discharged along a 30-foot wide access corridor during construction for the purpose of construction access. Material placed during construction within the 30-foot access corridor will be removed after construction. Activities that may result in discharges described as authorized by Nationwide Section 404 Permit No. 33 may occur.

22. Surface Area in Acres of Wetlands or Other Waters Filled (see instructions)

A total of up to 0.37 acres of waters of the U.S. will be filled: 0.002 acres from permanent structural discharges, and up to 0.368 acres for temporary construction access. All 0.37 acres of waters of the U.S. are wetlands, although river scour from year to year may render any portion of the wetlands as unvegetated stream channel as a result of natural scour and/or sediment deposition. Initial vegetation clearing for bridge construction within the 0.37-acre area may or may not result in a discharge of dredged or fill material. Therefore, clearing and construction/access related activities creating a discharge of dredged or fill material may occur within areas ranging from 0.0 to 0.368 acres, and such discharges may not occur at all. Note that grading in uplands adjacent the San Luis Rey River will result in creation of 2.3 acres of riparian habitat as a result of the proposed project.


