Biological Objectives for Water Bodies in the San Diego Region




Recommendation: Develop biological water quality objectives for inland surface waters

Chollas Creek Metals Site Specific Water Effect Ratio



Recommendation: Revise the Basin Plan based upon the results of the completed water effect ratio study prepared by the City of San Diego.

Evaluate Contact Water Recreation (REC-1) WQOs and Assessment



Recommendation: Evaluate the science that could lead to revised REC-1 water quality objectives, TMDLs and compliance determination
