

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
AND NPDES STORMWATER PERMIT AMENDMENT  
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD  
SAN DIEGO REGION**

Pursuant to the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permitting program, under the California Porter-Cologne Act and the federal Clean Water Act, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) hereby gives notice of the following proposed actions:

- Adoption of Tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. R9-2007-0001, NPDES Permit No. CAS0108758, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Urban Runoff from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) Draining the Watersheds of the County of San Diego, the Incorporated Cities of San Diego County, the San Diego Unified Port District and the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority.

Tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. R9-2007-0001 will extend the deadlines of certain permit requirements by 60 days. The extension of the deadlines is necessitated by the recent wildfires of October 2007 and the unforeseeable delays in previously scheduled work required by Order No. R9-2007-0001 that has resulted from the wildfires.

The Regional Board has made Tentative Addendum No. 1 to Order No. R9-2007-0001 available for public review and comment beginning November 13, 2007. Only comments on the Tentative Addendum No. 1 will be considered. The relevant documents are available by request from the Regional Board or at:

To facilitate public comment, a public hearing will be conducted concerning the proposed changes of the Tentative Addendum to Order No. R9-2007-0001. The public hearing will consist of presentations describing how the requirements of Order No. R9-2007-0001 will be affected by the adoption of the Tentative Addendum No. 1, an opportunity for public comments and questions, and time for responses to public comments and questions. The Regional Board will consider the proposed action at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held at the following time and location:

The official public review and comment period is the opportunity for interested parties to provide comment on the proposed deadline extensions. Written comments or testimony on the proposed changes included in Tentative Addendum No. 1 should be submitted to the Regional Board as soon as possible, but no later than 5:00 PM December 5, 2007. Only written comments or testimony received by 5:00 PM on December 5, 2007 will be provided to the Regional Board members for their consideration prior to the December 12, 2007 public hearing. The Regional Board will consider oral statements at the December 12, 2007 public hearing.
