Subject: Administrative Draft of Regional MS4 Permit

Stakeholders:

The San Diego Water Board is considering the development and adoption of a Regional Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Storm Water NPDES Permit (Regional MS4 Permit) that will be issued to municipal Copermittees in San Diego County, Southern Orange County and Riverside County. Currently, each of these counties within the San Diego Region has its own municipal storm water permit. In order to better achieve regulatory consistency as well as maximum efficiency and economy of resources, the San Diego Water Board developed a single Regional MS4 Permit based on the boundaries of the San Diego Region instead of county political boundaries. Under this approach, the permit will uniformly regulate all three counties within the San Diego Region.

An administrative draft of the Regional MS4 Permit is posted on the San Diego Water Boards website at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/water_issues/programs/stormwater/index.shtml. At the upcoming April 25, 2012 workshop, the San Diego Water Board will inform stakeholders about the administrative draft review process, focused work group meetings, and the formal public review and permit adoption schedule. Workshop participants may present comments and ask clarifying questions regarding the Regional MS4 Administrative Draft Permit. Written comments may also be submitted in advance to help frame discussion during the Workshop. The San Diego Water Board may respond to, but will not necessarily provide oral or written responses to, the comments received prior to or at the Workshop. **Written comments received by the San Diego Water Board on or before June 15, 2012 will be considered in development of the Tentative Order.**
