**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
ON
CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**

**City of Calistoga, Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant,
1100 Dunaweal Lane, Calistoga, CA 94515, Napa County**

The above discharger owns and operates the Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant, which treats wastewater from domestic, commercial, and industrial sources in the City of Calistoga. The discharger is permitted to discharge treated wastewater to the Napa River under an NPDES permit and recycle tertiary-treated wastewater for landscape irrigation under a General Reuse Order. Board staff has prepared a tentative cease and desist order that would require correction of threatened violations of discharge prohibitions in the NPDES permit and General Reuse Order, and violations of an antimony discharge limit.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the tentative cease and desist order is 5:00 p.m. on October 9, 2014. Comments must be sent to the **attention of John Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on or objections to the tentative order or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the tentative order during a meeting to commence at **9:00 a.m. on November 12, 2014**, in the Auditorium of the Elihu Harris Building at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party that challenges the Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.
