RESOLUTION NO. 74-6.

AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 73-18 CONCERNING
THE BOUNDARIES OF THE AREA OF STINSON BEACH IN MARIN COUNTY
TO WHICH APPLIES A PROHIBITION AGAINST WASTE DISCHARGES
TO INDIVIDUAL LEACHING OR PERCOLATION SYSTEMS.

- I. WHEREAS the Regional Board, at the meeting of September 25, 1973, adopted Resolution 73-13, which amended the Water Quality Control Plan (Interim) San Francisco Bay Basin, to prohibit waste discharges to individual leaching or percolation systems in the Stinson Beach area of Marin County, and
- II. WHEREAS the Board, at the meeting of November 27, 1973, adopted Resolution 73-18 which redefined the area covered by the discharge prohibition to exclude areas to be included in the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, and to add some areas in the Panoramic area, and
- III. WHEREAS adequate legal notice was not given of the Board's intention to add areas to the area covered by the discharge prohibition;
- IV. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Regional Board amends Resolution 73-18 as follows:

Under item IV, the paragraph which begins, "The Stinson Beach area is defined to include the following:" is hereby deleted, and in its place the following paragraph is hereby added:

The Stinson Beach area is defined to include the following: Stinson State Beach, the Seadrift Sand Spit, and all lands extending from these areas to the boundaries of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area as established in HR 16444; but excluding all lands to the east of a line drawn from the Rancho Baulines boundary at the 600 foot elevation to the southeastern boundary of Stinson State Beach.
