RESOLUTION NO. 70-37

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 68-8 PRESCRIBING REVISED REQUIREMENTS  
FOR WASTE DISCHARGE BY EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT,  
SPECIAL DISTRICT NO. 1 INTO SAN FRANCISCO BAY, ALAMEDA COUNTY

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS DISCHARGE

1. This Regional Water Quality Control Board prescribed requirements for East Bay Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1, called the discharger below, in Resolution No. 68-8, adopted March 21, 1968.
2. East Bay Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1 is discharging approximately 70,000 gallons per day of digested sludge, with an increased amount during canning season, through its sewage treatment plant outfall to the Bay.
3. On August 28, 1969, a motion containing the following statement was adopted:  

"This Regional Board instructs its staff to present recommendations  
..... relative to ..... correction of problems caused by  
the District's sludge disposal practices."
4. The District adopted a tentative time schedule on March 31, 1970 for installation of interim sludge disposal facilities.

RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD

1. The requirements prescribed in this Board's Resolution No. 68-8 for this waste discharge are hereby amended to include the following:

PROHIBITION

Pursuant to Section 13243 of the California Water Code, the discharge of digested sludge to waters of the state is prohibited.

2. This Board finds that the time schedule outlined below represents an adequate amount of time for East Bay Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1 to comply with this Board's "Prohibition" described in item 1 above and that failure of the District to complete any step in accordance with this schedule will be cause for the Board to consider the issuance of an Order to Cease and Desist pursuant to Section 13301 of the California Water Code.

Award of contract for design of all necessary facilities	April 24, 1970
Complete construction plans and specifications for the necessary facilities	July 8, 1970
Advertise for bids	July 27, 1970
Open bids	August 27, 1970
Award contract(s) for construction of the necessary facilities	September 8, 1970
Complete construction of the necessary facilities	July 15, 1971

3. Notwithstanding the above time schedule, this Regional Board reserves the right to issue a cease and desist order to the District at any time for the violation of requirements of Resolution No. 68-8, as amended.
4. East Bay Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1 is required to file written progress reports with this Regional Board on or before each of the following dates:
  - A. May 1, 1970
  - B. July 15, 1970
  - C. August 5, 1970
  - D. September 15, 1970
  - E. March 15, 1971
  - F. July 23, 1971
