RESOLUTION NO. 70-41

STATEMENT OF INTENT WITH RESPECT TO  
RESTRICTION OF CONNECTION TO SEWERAGE  
SYSTEM OF CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

WHEREAS

1. The State Water Resources Control Board and this Regional Board have taken the following actions:
  - a. State Board adopted its Order 70-1 on March 14, 1970, which restricts connections to the sewer system tributary to the Southeast Sewage Treatment Plant of the City and County of San Francisco (hereinafter "San Francisco").
  - b. Regional Board adopted its Resolution No. 70-18 on March 26, 1970, which restricts connections to the sewer system tributary to San Francisco's North Point Sewage Treatment Plant.
  - c. State Board, by motion of April 2, 1970, formally remanded to this Regional Board full and continuing jurisdiction over the case involving the waste discharge from the Southeast plant.
2. San Francisco retained the consulting services of Mr. John Parkhurst to recommend interim measures for upgrading treatment at the North Point and Southeast plants.
3. The San Francisco Director of Public Works, in a letter dated April 17, 1970, reported on status of improvements recommended by the consulting engineer and other corrective actions by the City.
4. On May 5, 1970, staff members of the State and Regional Boards made an inspection of the work accomplished at the two treatment plants.
5. The State Board on May 7, and the Regional Board on May 11, 1970, heard staff reports on the status of improvements by San Francisco and discussed the restriction of connections to the sewer system.
6. The Consulting Engineer for San Francisco and the State and Regional Board staffs report that the improvements now being made at the two treatment plants will, when completed and in operation, result in substantial reduction in pollution loads on the Bay; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED

This Regional Board will at its special meeting on May 19, 1970, amend the orders to remove the restriction on connections to the sewer systems if it finds

on that date the following with respect to the measures outlined in the letter of April 17, 1970, from the Director of Public Works.

- (a) Those items scheduled for completion on or before May 19, 1970 are completed and in operation.
- (b) Those items which had completion dates after May 19, 1970, are on schedule.
