RESOLUTION NO. 70-84

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 70-53 TO ADOPT A  
COMPLIANCE TIME SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF HAYWARD

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS DISCHARGE

1. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 70-53, prescribing revised waste discharge requirements for the City of Hayward, called the discharger below, into San Francisco Bay, on June 25, 1970.
2. The City of Hayward, by its Council's Resolution No. 70-322 adopted July 23, 1970, has approved a schedule of compliance with the waste discharge requirements of Resolution No. 70-53 no later than January 15, 1973.
3. This Regional Board has urged the discharger and five other East Bay dischargers to develop a coordinated subregional water quality control program consistent with the general concepts of Phase I of the plan recommended by the Final Bay-Delta Program Report.

RESOLVED BY THIS REGIONAL BOARD

1. Pursuant to Section 13263(c) of the California Water Code, this Regional Board adopts the following time schedule for compliance with the requirements of Resolution No. 70-53:

a. DISINFECTION FACILITIES

Award contract for Disinfection Facilities	by December 15, 1970
Compliance with Disinfection Requirements	by March 1, 1971
Completion of interim plant enlargements including rebuilt tide gate of outfall channel	by August 1, 1971.

b. MODIFIED STAGE II ENLARGEMENTS

Authorized preliminary engineering of modified Stage II enlargements	by November 1, 1970
Authorize design - Stage II enlargements	by March 1, 1971
Bond Election	by June 30, 1971
Complete final plans and specifications	by August 1, 1971

Advertise for bids	by October 1, 1971
Review bids and award contract	by December 1, 1971
Complete construction	by June 15, 1972
Demonstrate compliance with all requirements of Resolution No. 70-53	by December 15, 1972.

c. SUBREGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL PROGRAM

Authorize participation in subregional water quality control program study	by November 15, 1970
Complete subregional program study	by November 1, 1971.

2. The Regional Board requires, as a condition for its approval of any construction grant application, that the City participate in a subregional program for consolidation, treatment and disposal of its waste water which is consistent with the general concepts of Phase I of the Bay-Delta Report and which meets the approval of the Regional Board. The subregional study will include at least the following entities:

East Bay Municipal Utility District  
 City of San Leandro  
 Oro Loma Sanitary District  
 Castro Valley Sanitary District  
 Union Sanitary District

3. The discharger is required to file written progress reports with this Regional Board pursuant to Section 13267 of the California Water Code within 15 days after each of the dates specified above.
4. This compliance time schedule is subject to revision in the discretion of this Regional Board.
5. If the discharger fails to comply with this schedule, the Executive Officer is instructed to bring a recommendation on the initiation of formal enforcement proceedings to the Regional Board for its consideration.
