RESOLUTION NO. 70-96

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 70-34, "ORDERING CALIFORNIA AND HAWAIIAN SUGAR COMPANY TO CEASE AND DESIST VIOLATIONS OF THE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 68-65, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY"

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

This Regional Board on March 26, 1970 adopted Resolution No. 70-34, a cease and desist order, which required California and Hawaiian Sugar Company to complete waste treatment facilities by December 15, 1970, begin compliance with requirements by December 31, 1970 and demonstrate compliance with requirements by February 15, 1971.

The California and Hawaiian Sugar Company has reported delays in this schedule because of a strike for over sixteen weeks, reported that completion of facilities is now scheduled for March 1, 1971, and that compliance with requirements will be demonstrated by April 30, 1971 and requested modification of the time schedule in Resolution No. 70-34.

RESOLVED BY THIS REGIONAL BOARD

This Regional Board hereby amends the time schedule of Resolution No. 70-34 to read as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE REGIONAL BOARD

1. The California and Hawaiian Sugar Company is hereby ordered to cease and desist discharging waste in violation of requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 68-65 pursuant to the following time schedule:

Complete construction of the necessary facilities, as evidenced by acceptance of the work by the discharger	March 1, 1971
Begin compliance with the requirements of Resolution No. 68-65	March 15, 1971
Demonstrate compliance with requirements of Resolution No. 68-65 as evidenced by appropriate data collected by the discharger and filed at the office of the Regional Board	April 30, 1971

2. Pursuant to Sections 13267(b) and 13268 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board requires the discharger to file written progress reports on each of the following dates. Each such report shall be accompanied by a letter signed by the discharger's plant manager or higher official, certifying that the policy-making body is adequately informed about the report.
