ORDER NO. 71-32

AMENDING ORDER NO. 71-15 BY ADOPTING A COMPLIANCE
TIME SCHEDULE FOR MOE SAND COMPANY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

1. This Regional Board adopted Order No. 71-15 prescribing waste discharge requirements for Moe Sand Company on February 25, 1971 for discharges from hydraulic sand dredging (Waste A) and hydraulic sand unloading (Waste B) operations.
2. Moe Sand Company submitted a time schedule pursuant to the requirements of Order No. 71-15 in letters dated March 3, 1971 and April 7, 1971.
3. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and individuals of its intent to adopt a compliance time schedule for those waste discharge requirements.
4. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, Moe Sand Company shall comply with the following:

A. Time schedule for compliance with waste discharge requirements on:

1. Hydraulic Dredging Facilities (for Waste A)

Complete design	by July 1, 1971
Complete construction	by November 1, 1971
Demonstrate compliance with requirements	by December 31, 1971

2. Hydraulic Unloading Facilities (for Waste B)

Complete design	by January 31, 1972
Complete financial arrangements	by March 31, 1972
Start of construction	by May 31, 1972
Demonstrate compliance with requirements	by December 31, 1972

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, if the discharger fails to comply with the foregoing schedule, the Executive Officer is instructed to bring a recommendation on the initiation of formal enforcement proceedings to the Regional Board for its consideration.

B. Provisions

Moe Sand Company is required to file written progress reports with this Regional Board within 15 days after each of the dates specified above.
