ORDER NO. 72-47

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NOS. 67-34 AND 67-57
FOR
CITY OF MARTINEZ
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region finds that:

- A. On November 16, 1967, Resolution No. 67-57, an Order to Cease and Desist violations of the waste discharge requirements of Resolution No. 67-34 was issued to the City of Martinez.
- B. On March 1, 1968, annexation of the City of Martinez to the Central Contra Costa Sanitary District was officially completed, and operational responsibility for the Martinez wastewater treatment plant was assumed by the Sanitary District.
- C. Inspection by the Board's staff has confirmed that the City of Martinez plant sewage discharge and the Fairview septic tank sewage discharge have been discontinued. Interception of these discharges to the Central Contra Costa Sanitary District Plant commenced early in 1972.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This Board's Resolutions No. 67-34 and 67-57 are rescinded.
