ORDER NO. 77-105

NPDES NO. CA0037974

ORDER REQUIRING SAN PABLO SANITARY DISTRICT  
TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM DISCHARGING WASTES  
CONTRARY TO REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE  
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL  
BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region  
finds:

- A. On October 15, 1974, the Regional Board adopted Order No. 74-101, an NPDES Permit, prescribing waste discharge requirements covering the waste discharge of San Pablo Sanitary District, hereinafter referred to as the discharger.
- B. On August 19, 1975, the Regional Board adopted Order No. 75-54 to amend Order No. 74-101, and revise the compliance time schedule.
- C. The discharge requirements in Order No. 74-101 provide, in part, as follows:

...

"D. Discharge Prohibitions

...

2. There shall be no bypass or overflow of untreated wastewater to waters of the State either at the treatment plant or from the collection system."

- D. The discharge requirements in Order No. 74-101 as amended, by Order No. 75-54 provide, in part, as follows:

"B. Receiving Water Limitations

...

2. The discharge of waste shall not cause the following limits to be exceeded in waters of the State in any place within one foot of the water surface:"

Adopt rate for the property tax or sewer service charge necessary to provide sufficient financing	August 10, 1977
Complete design	August 31, 1977
Advertise for bids	December 1, 1977
Start construction of transport facilities	March 1, 1978
Start construction of outfall	July 1, 1978
Complete construction of transport facilities	March 1, 1980
Complete construction of outfall	March 1, 1980
Full compliance	March 15, 1980

- C. The discharger shall comply with Board Order Nos. 74-101 and 75-74 for discharge prohibition D.2. during times of peak wet weather flow in accord with the following schedule:

<u>Task</u>	<u>Completion Date</u>
Adopt method of financing	December 1, 1977
Complete design	July 1, 1978
Advertise for bids	October 1, 1978
Start construction	January 1, 1979
Complete construction	January 1, 1981
Full compliance	January 15, 1981

- D. The discharger is required to provide to the Board by August 15, 1977 and monthly thereafter, a report, under penalty of perjury, on progress toward compliance with the provisions of this Order.

E. If, in the determination of the Executive Officer, the discharger fails to comply with the provisions of this Order, the Executive Officer is authorized to take the following action after approval of the Board Chairman:

- . Request the Attorney General to take the appropriate enforcement action against the discharger, including injunction and civil monetary remedies, if appropriate; and/or
- . Schedule a hearing for the Board to consider whether to restrict or prohibit the volume, type, or concentration of waste that may be added to the sewer system.

If the Executive Officer determines that the provisions of this Order are violated and does not refer the matter to the Attorney General or schedule a hearing to consider a restriction on additional discharges to the sewer system, he is instructed to report to the Board the reasons that the discharger has been unable to comply with the provisions of this Order.
