ORDER NO. 79-76

ENFORCEMENT ORDER FOR ISSUANCE OF A TIME SCHEDULE

Order directing Rodeo Sanitary District (hereinafter discharger) to comply with requirements prescribed by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region Order No. 79-75 (NPDES Permit No. CA0037826).

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, (hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. The Board on August 20, 1974, adopted Order 74-83 (NPDES CA0037826) prescribing waste discharge requirements for the discharger. The Board amended the Order on May 20, 1975 by adopting Order 75-28. The Board adopted Order 79-75 on June 19, 1979, revising the permit and rescinding the two previous orders.
2. The discharger has submitted evidence that compliance with certain provisions of Order 79-75 cannot be achieved until its deepwater outfall is constructed.
3. The discharger has submitted a time schedule to complete construction and to achieve full compliance with the requirements of Order No. 79-75.
4. The Board finds that this action is an order to enforce waste discharge requirements previously adopted by the Board. This action is therefore categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15121 of the Resources Agency Guidelines.
5. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to adopt a time schedule for compliance.
6. The Board in a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to this discharger's ability to achieve compliance.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that in accordance with Water Code Section 13300 Rodeo Sanitary District shall comply with the provisions of Order No. 79-75. as follows:

1. Compliance with Prohibition C.1 (dilution) and Receiving Water Objectives B.1.c (turbidity and discoloration) and B.2.d (ammonia hydroxide) shall be according to the following schedule:

2. This Order expires on July 1, 1981.		
3. The action taken by this Board pertaining to the time schedule does not preclude the possibility of actions to enforce the permit by third parties pursuant to Section 505 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
