ORDER NO. 93-014

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

CITY OF BRISBANE

SIERRA POINT MARINA

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter the Regional Board) finds that:

1. On December 19, 1978, the Regional Board issued Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No. 79-109 to the City of Brisbane (hereinafter the Discharger) for the dredging and construction of Sierra Point Marina.
2. The WDR's regulated the Discharger's dredging and construction of a marina facility.
3. Dredging consisted of 275,500 cubic yards of material which was to be disposed of at the Alcatraz Dredged Material Disposal site (SF-11).
4. The Discharger completed construction and dredging activities in 1981.
5. Section 13263(e) of the California Water Code directs the Regional Board to periodically review and revise Waste Discharge Requirements as appropriate. The discharge has ceased and the waste discharge requirements are no longer needed.
6. The Regional Board's rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with 14 CCR Section 15263.
7. The Regional Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission action.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order 78-109 is rescinded.
