RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY, SUNNYVALE; HONEYWELL INC. AND THE RREEF FUNDS, SANTA CLARA; PRECISION MONOLITHICS INC., SANTA CLARA, INTERSIL INC., CUPERTINO; INTERSIL INC., SUNNYVALE; SIEMENS COMPONENTS, INC., CUPERTINO; VAN WATERS & ROGERS INC., SAN JOSE; GREAT WESTERN CHEMICAL CO., MILPITAS; AND JONES CHEMICALS INC., MILPITAS, SANTA CLARA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter the Board) finds that:

1. The Board issued the following individual NPDES permits for discharges of extracted, treated groundwater:

2. All of these NPDES permits have expired and have been extended pursuant to EPA regulations (40 CFR 122.6).
3. Individual NPDES permits are no longer needed for these discharges. All of these discharges are eligible for coverage under NPDES general permit CAG912003, issued by the Board on July 20, 1994, as Order No. 94-087 (general waste discharge requirements). All of these dischargers have submitted the technical information required for obtaining coverage under this NPDES general permit.
4. In order to avoid any lapse in coverage by a valid NPDES permit, the above-cited dischargers need to receive an Executive Officer letter of authorization confirming their coverage under the above-cited NPDES general permit, before their individual NPDES permits are rescinded.
5. The rescission of waste discharge requirements (NPDES permits) for the discharges is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 13389 of the California Water Code.
6. The Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind waste discharge requirements (NPDES permits) for the discharges and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
7. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharges.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Board Order Nos. 86-084, 87-050, 87-051, 85-119, 87-137, 88-139, 87-104, 87-045, 87-006, 87-024, and 87-027 are rescinded, effective July 31, 1994.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Executive Officer will send letters of authorization to each of the above-cited dischargers confirming their coverage under NPDES general permit CAG912003. Such letters will be sent prior to July 31, 1994.
