ORDER NO. 95-080

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER No. 86-055 FOR

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
AND THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
MOUNTAIN VIEW LANDFILL GAS RECOVERY PLANT
MOUNTAIN VIEW, SANTA CLARA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, (hereinafter called the Board) finds that:

1. On January 25, 1986, Pacific Gas and Electric Company applied for a permit to actively discharge landfill gas condensate into Area 1C of the City of Mountain View Solid Waste Site. Pacific Gas and Electric Company (operators of the Plant) and the City of Mountain View (owners of the Mountain View Landfill) are hereinafter collectively referred to as the discharger.
2. The Mountain View Landfill Gas Recovery Plant site, as shown on Figure 1, which is incorporated herein and made part of this Order, was located at the easterly end of Stierlin Road between Charleston Slough and Stevens Creek within the boundary of the City of Mountain View Landfill in Santa Clara County.
3. On July 16, 1986, the Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 86-055 and allowed the Pacific Gas and Electric Company to discharge gas condensate into Area 1C of the landfill.
4. The Plant ceased operation in 1990.
5. The discharger has reported that the equipment for the Mountain View Landfill Gas Recovery Plant have been dismantled and removed from the property, the facility structures have been demolished and the property has been returned to the City of Mountain View.
6. The City of Mountain View has acknowledged the preceding finding .
7. On June 7, 1994 the Pacific Gas and Electric Company requested the State Water Resource Control Board and the Board to rescind its Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 86-055.
8. This action is exempted from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15308, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

9. The Board notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind waste discharge requirements, and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and to submit their written views and recommendation.
10. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharges.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to provisions contained in Division 7 of the California Water Code and regulations adopted thereunder, Order No. 86-055 is hereby rescinded.




Figure 1
