AMENDMENT OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. 91-052

KELLER CANYON LANDFILL COMPANY
CLASS II SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITE
PITTSBURG, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, (hereinafter called the Board), finds:

1. Keller Canyon Landfill Company (hereinafter the discharger) operates a 2628 acre site with a Class II solid waste disposal area of 244 acres. The landfill is located in the City of Pittsburg, Contra Costa County.
2. The discharger has requested that Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-052 be amended to allow an alternative design for the liner in the Phase 2A Unit. This proposed design meets the Chapter 15, Title 23, CCR requirements for an engineered alternative.
3. This amendment is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulation.
4. The Board, in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to this amendment of waste discharge requirements.

It is hereby ordered that:

Page 11, Specification 13 of Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-052 is amended to include a new second paragraph as follows: An alternative design is acceptable in the approximately 3.1 acre Phase 2A area above the engineered fill of the toe berm. Such an alternative design includes from the bottom to top a geosynthetic clay liner, an 80-mil textured high density polyethylene liner, a leachate collection and removal system that will consist of a geosynthetic drainage net and geotextile filter fabric and a minimum 1- foot-thick protective soil cover layer.
