ORDER NO. 98-082

NPDES PERMIT NUMBERS 2438312002 AND 2494054001
RESCISSION OF ORDER NUMBERS 93-158 AND 93-108, WASTE DISCHARGE
REQUIREMENTS FOR: LYNCH CIRCUITS, INC. AND SILICONIX, INC., 1140 WEST
EVELYN AVENUE, SUNNYVALE, SANTA CLARA COUNTY; AND SOLA OPTICAL
USA, INC., 1500 CADER LANE, PETALUMA, SONOMA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region
(hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. The Board issued the following individual NPDES permits for discharge of
extracted and treated groundwater:

2. These individual NPDES permits are no longer needed. The discharger in item
number 1 applied for and received a discharge authorization letter under an NPDES
general permit for extraction, treatment, and discharge of groundwater. The
discharger in item number 2 may need a permit next summer. In that case, this
discharger will apply for and may receive a permit under a NPDES general permit.
3. The rescission of waste discharge requirements (NPDES permit) for the discharge is
exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
pursuant to Section 13389 of the California Water Code.
4. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its
intent to rescind waste discharge requirements (NPDES permit) for the discharge,
and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity
to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the
discharge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Board Order Numbers 93-158 and 93-108 are rescinded.
