RESCISSION OF ORDER NUMBER 94-185, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:
SANTA CLARA TRANSPORTATION AGENCY, DON PEDRO CHABOYA STATION,
SANTA CLARA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. The Board issued the following individual NPDES permit for discharge of extracted and treated groundwater:



2. Groundwater extracted at the site is treated and reinfiltred back into the ground onsite. The reinfiltred of groundwater is regulated under Order No. 95-133, the Site Cleanup Requirements for the site. The NPDES permit was issued in case treated groundwater needed to be discharged to a storm drain in the event that the amount of extracted groundwater exceeded the reinfiltred capacity. This never occurred nor is it expected to occur. This individual NPDES permit is no longer needed.
3. The rescission of waste discharge requirements (NPDES permit) for the discharge is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 13389 of the California Water Code.
4. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind waste discharge requirements (NPDES permit) for the discharge, and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
5. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Board Order Number 94-185 is rescinded.
