NPDES Permit No. CAG0038644**

**RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:
NAPA RIVER RECLAMATION DISTRICT #2109
NAPA, NAPA COUNTY**


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter the Water Board) finds that:

1. Napa River Reclamation District #2109, formerly Edgerly Island Reclamation District, is located at 1501 Milton Road, Napa, Napa County.
2. The District operates a sewage collection and treatment plant serving the community of Edgerly Island in Napa County. The plant provides secondary level treatment for domestic wastewater.
3. The potential discharge of wastewater from this facility was previously covered under NPDES Permit No. CA 0038644, Order No. 93-119.
4. The treatment facility was designed to discharge, if necessary, between December 1 and April 30 of each year, about 82,000 gallons per day to drainage channels that are part of a marsh restoration project that drains to Mud Slough and thence to Napa River. The discharge has never occurred in the roughly 13 years since the NPDES permit was issued, and future discharge is unlikely because adequate storage and evaporation capacity exist within on-site ponds.
5. Provision F.12 of Order No. 93-119 requires that the District submit a report of waste discharge for reissuance of NPDES permit 180 days prior to the expiration date. The expiration date of Permit No. CA0038644 is February 17, 1998.
6. The District did not submit an application for permit reissuance until January 17, 2005. The application was incomplete because it did not include U.S. EPA Forms 2A and 2S and California Form 200.
7. Because a complete application was not submitted 180 days prior to the expiration date, pursuant to 40CFR122.6(a) (1), NPDES Permit No. CA0038644 automatically expired on February 17, 1998.

8. Since no discharge has occurred for many years, an NPDES permit for this facility is no longer necessary. Furthermore, since the NPDES Permit No. CA0038644 has expired, it needs to be rescinded formally.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Order No. 93-119 is rescinded.
